Learner context influences engagement, evidence collection, and assessment risk

RPL outcomes and supported progression


Clear unit-level decisions support both outcome integrity and learner progression

Stage 6

Decision-making, communication, and audit visibility



Clear decision trails make RPL judgements transparent, auditable, and support consistency

Key Messages

- RPL is a structured pathway, not an administrative shortcut
- Diversity in evidence supports fairness when the assessor's judgment is sound
- Integrity is protected through judgment, validation, and industry engagement
- Learner wellbeing applies throughout the RPL pathway
- Clear, unit-level RPL decisions can support learner progression while maintaining competency standard outcomes
