



QUALITY POLICY STATEMENT



REC is a Division of the Resource and Environmental Regulation Group (RER). REC operates offices located in East Perth (Head Office).

The REC Division operates and maintains a Management System that meets the requirements of ISO 9001:2015, legislation, regulations and subscribed codes of practice. REC's scope of ISO 9001:2015 certification covers the management of compliance and regulatory services.

The REC Division's objective is to use resources efficiently, minimise waste, support climate action initiatives and maintain a safe, healthy and friendly working environment for workers, visitors and the general public.
