STATEWIDE SERVICES: DISCRIMINATION AND HUMAN RIGHTS

These services commonly assist with discrimination related to race, disability, gender, sexuality, age, migration status, workplace issues, or access to services.

Provides culturally safe legal services for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, including criminal law, family law, and civil matters across WA.

CASE for Refugees | Phone: (08) 9227 7311

Provides specialist legal assistance to asylum seekers and refugees, including discrimination, human rights, and migration related matters.

Circle Green Community Legal | Phone: (08) 6148 3636

Provides statewide legal assistance with workplace rights, including discrimination and sexual harassment, as well as tenancy and immigration matters.
