



WA's weekly fuel update

as of 1:00pm, 15 May 2026

Summary of current situation:

What we have achieved this week:

- **Fuel supply** into Western Australian and distribution to key regions and industries **remains uninterrupted**.
- **An additional 8 million litres of diesel for the State Strategic Stockpile** was delivered this week. We now have **20 million litres of diesel** available in Wyndham, Geraldton, Kalgoorlie, Esperance and Kwinana for when we need it.
- In the State Budget we introduced a **\$100 Fuel Support Payment for all people with a valid Western Australian driver's licence**, including learner's permits, provisional and extraordinary driver's licences.
- This cost-of-living measure will **help Western Australians with fuel costs** and can be claimed via the ServiceWA app from July 1.
- **Fuel stockouts remain low** across the 900 locations on Fuelwatch giving confidence to drivers that fuel is generally available across the State.
- **Over 1400 proactive inspections have been conducted of fuel stations** so far this year resulting in 82 infringements for non-compliance with FuelWatch requirements.
- Amendments to the Fuel, Energy and Power Resources Act 1972 progressed through the Upper House this week. Changes to the Act will help the State manage any future escalation.

What we are working to address:

- **Looking at additional storage opportunities to expand WA's strategic Fuel Stockpile** to help us respond quickly to any future acute demand spikes in regional and rural WA.
- **Continue to plan** for potential major fuel supply disruptions and an escalation under the National Fuel Security Plan.
