



WA's weekly fuel update

as of 1:00pm, 22 May 2026

Summary of current situation:

What we have achieved this week:

- The FuelWatch website has now **added 225 new sites from across regional Western Australia.**
- Adding these new sites will give drivers **greater visibility of fuel availability and price** across the whole State.
- A further **99 proactive inspections** were conducted last week on fuel outlets, bringing the **total number of inspections to 1533** since the beginning of the compliance blitz.
- **The level of fuel stockouts remains low**, with an average of less than 1% of all outlets experiencing a stockout at any one time.
- This is the **lowest level of fuel stockouts in Australia.**
- Fuel supply into Western Australian and distribution to key regions and industries remains uninterrupted.
- Fuel companies are confident that shipments will arrive as planned for June and early July.
- The Fuel Industry Operations Group continues to meet with **no major fuel shortages being reported by industry representatives.**

What we are working to address:

- **Work continues to ensure fuel remains available in key regions** for the upcoming harvest season and Senior High School Country Week.
- Preparations continue for any escalation under the National Fuel Security Plan.
