



WA's weekly fuel update

as of 3:30pm, 12 June 2026

Summary of current situation:

What we have achieved this week:

- **Fuel supply is currently secure into July**, with growing confidence for August.
- We have secured **an extra 50 million litres of diesel for WA** through the Federal Government, **plus an additional shipment of fertilizer, supporting farmers.**
- **Outages remain around 1%**, which is the lowest in the country, with the national average around 3.9%.
- Recent data shows **Perth's retail diesel prices are among the lowest in the nation.**
- Since the blitz began in March, **a total of 1755 fuel sites have been inspected, with infringements handed out to 94 outlets.**

What we are working to address:

- Preparations continue for any escalation under the **National Fuel Security Plan.**
