



WA's weekly fuel update

as of 2:00pm, 5 June 2026

Summary of current situation:

What we have achieved this week:

- **Last week 66 fuel outlets were inspected, and 8 infringements were issued.**
- **This brings the total to 1,749 inspections** since the blitz began in early March.
- **Total infringements for non-compliance** with FuelWatch requirements now **stand at 93.**
- **Fuel supply into Western Australian** and distribution to key regions and industries **remains uninterrupted.**
- Fuel companies report that **fuel supplies for June and July are secure,** with **growing confidence for August.**
- A **direct donate option for the \$100 Fuel Support Payment** has been introduced for those who wish to gift their payment to charity.
- This can be done via the **ServiceWA app from 1 July.**

What we are working to address:

- **Preparations continue** for any escalation under the National Fuel Security Plan.
