



WA's weekly fuel update

as of 12:30pm, 19 June 2026

Summary of current situation:

What we have achieved this week:

- Fuel companies report that **fuel supplies for June and July are secure**, with growing confidence for August.
- **Fuel stocks in Western Australia remain above average** and plans are in place to accommodate an increase in demand driven by school holidays and agricultural sector preparing for harvest later in the year.
- **The number of stockouts** reported to FuelWatch **remains low** giving confidence to those with school holiday travel plans.
- Last week **76 fuel outlets were inspected, and 6 infringements were issued.**
- This brings the total to **1,831 inspections** since the blitz began in March.
- Total infringements for non-compliance with FuelWatch requirements **now stand at 100.**

What we are working to address:

- Preparations continue for any potential changes **under the National Fuel Security Plan.**
