



# WA's weekly fuel update

as of 2:30pm, 26 June 2026

## Summary of current situation:

### What we have achieved this week:

- We've worked with the Federal Government to **extend the fuel excise cut for a further month**, easing cost pressures for Western Australians.
- **Almost 2000 FuelWatch inspections** have been conducted, with **more than 100 infringements** issued since the blitz began.
- **Fuel supply into Western Australian** and distribution to key regions and industries **remains uninterrupted**.
- Fuel companies report that **fuel supplies for June and July are secure**, with **growing confidence for August**.
- The number of **stockouts remains low**, giving confidence for school holiday travel plans.
- Holders of a valid WA driver's licence will be able to claim the **\$100 Fuel Support Payment** through the ServiceWA app **from Wednesday next week**.

### What we are working to address:

- **Preparations continue** for any escalation under the National Fuel Security Plan.

Fuel supply continues to operate effectively, but localised supply disruptions are occurring. Federal and State Governments are taking precautionary actions to shore up supply.
