- 2 If the vehicle holds a tank, or is a tanker, it must be licensed to transport bulk controlled waste. Use Form CW3 – Application for licence for vehicle or tank used to transport bulk controlled waste.
- 3 Provide details of all vehicles/trailers intended to be used for transporting controlled waste on Western Australian roads. If the vehicle is a prime mover or a prime mover/trailer combination, only the trailer needs to be registered. Prime movers do not need to be registered as packaged controlled waste vehicles.
