



WA's weekly fuel update

as of 3:30pm, 3 July 2026

Summary of current situation:

What we have achieved this week:

- **113 fuel stations were inspected this week** as part of our inspection blitz. To date **102 infringements have been issued**.
- On **July 1 the fuel excise discount went from 32 cents to 16 cents per litre**.
- The Commonwealth has asked the ACCC to monitor prices to ensure motorists are not being ripped off by fuel companies.
- Any concerns about pricing can be reported to **FuelWatch**.
- **Fuel stocks in Western Australia are higher now than the same time last year** and fuel station stockouts remain low.
- The fuel security **state of emergency remains in place until September**, and we are continuing to monitor the situation closely.
