We have organised several events during Keep Australia Beautiful Week and a key feature this year is SPOGOMI, the exciting litter-picking sport that turns environmental action into a team competition. Participants work in teams of three, collecting and sorting litter to earn points based on the type and volume of waste collected. The unique concept promotes teamwork, physical activity and environmental responsibility.

Two SPOGOMI events will be held during the week; a regional competition at Koombana Bay, Bunbury on 3 August and a metropolitan event at City Beach on 4 August. Both events aim to inspire schools and communities to see litter-prevention as a fun, engaging and rewarding activity. Australian SPOGOMI ambassador, Jason Partington, will attend both events.

Throughout the week, communities across WA can also participate in clean-ups, school activities, litter audits and environmental education initiatives designed to encourage lasting behaviour change and community pride.

Whether you're competing in SPOGOMI, joining a local clean-up or simply putting your rubbish in the bin, every action helps create cleaner, healthier and happier places for everyone
