

Collection Notice – Office of the Appeals Convenor

The independent Office of the Appeals Convenor (OAC) collects your personal information such as your name, contact details, organisation (if applicable), and information provided in your appeal submission, and any supporting documents in order to: receive, register, assess and administer environmental appeals, and communicate with you about your submission.

The Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER) collects personal information only for payment of fees where this is applicable.

This information is required under the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (WA). The OAC and DWER will handle your personal information in accordance with the [Privacy and Responsible Information Sharing Act 2024 \(WA\)](#), and DWER's published [privacy and responsible information-handling framework](#). If you choose not to provide the requested personal information, your appeal may not be able to be processed or considered.

The OAC may share this information with the Minister for the Environment, relevant government agencies, and other parties, for the purpose of investigating, assessing, and determining environmental appeals, and progressing the appeals process.
