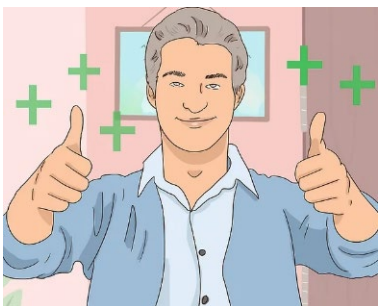

You might see a word that you do not understand.



You can look it up in an Easy Read factsheet called the Hard Words factsheet.

You do not need a computer to access OPA **information**.



Information can be sent to you in the post.



You can call the OPA advice line and talk to someone.



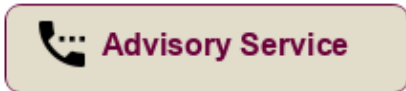
You can ask questions.



The OPA advice line is open from 9.00am to 4.30pm, Monday to Friday.



The phone number is 1300 858 455.
