## Rainfall, streamflow and groundwater

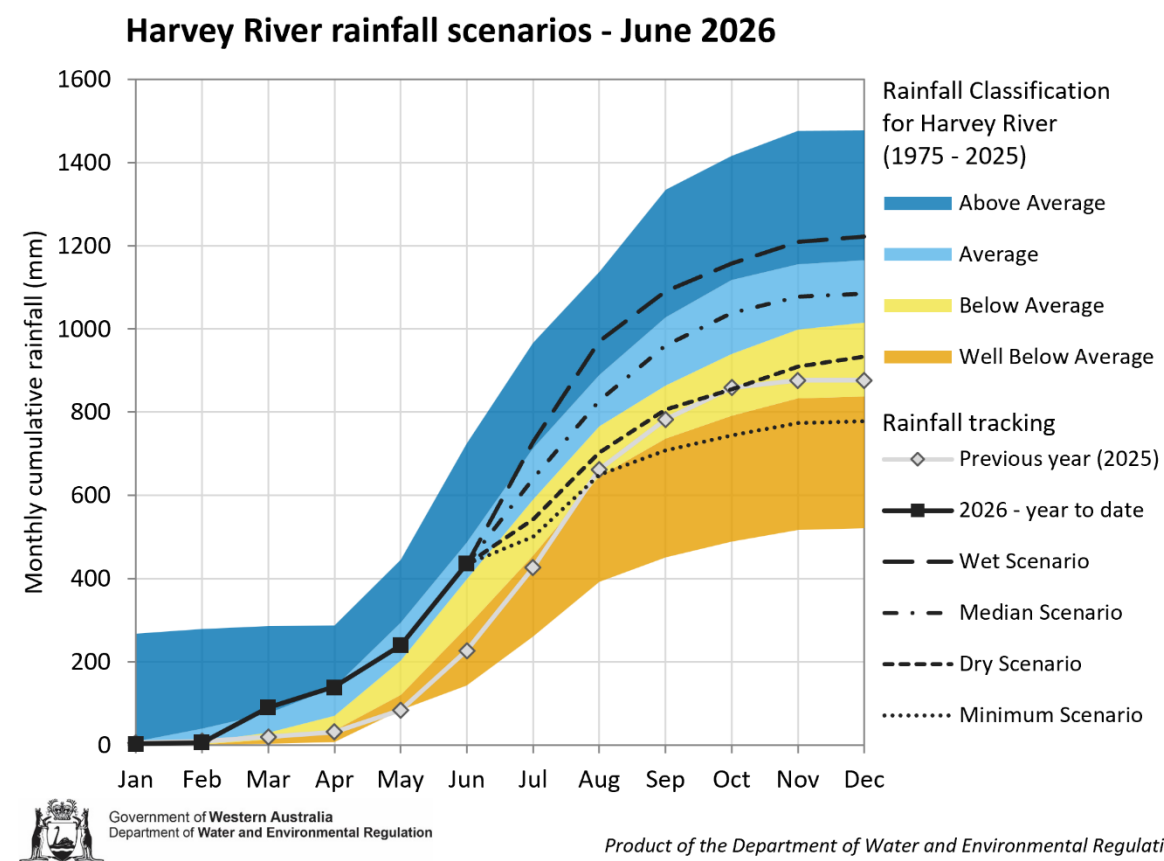
### Rainfall

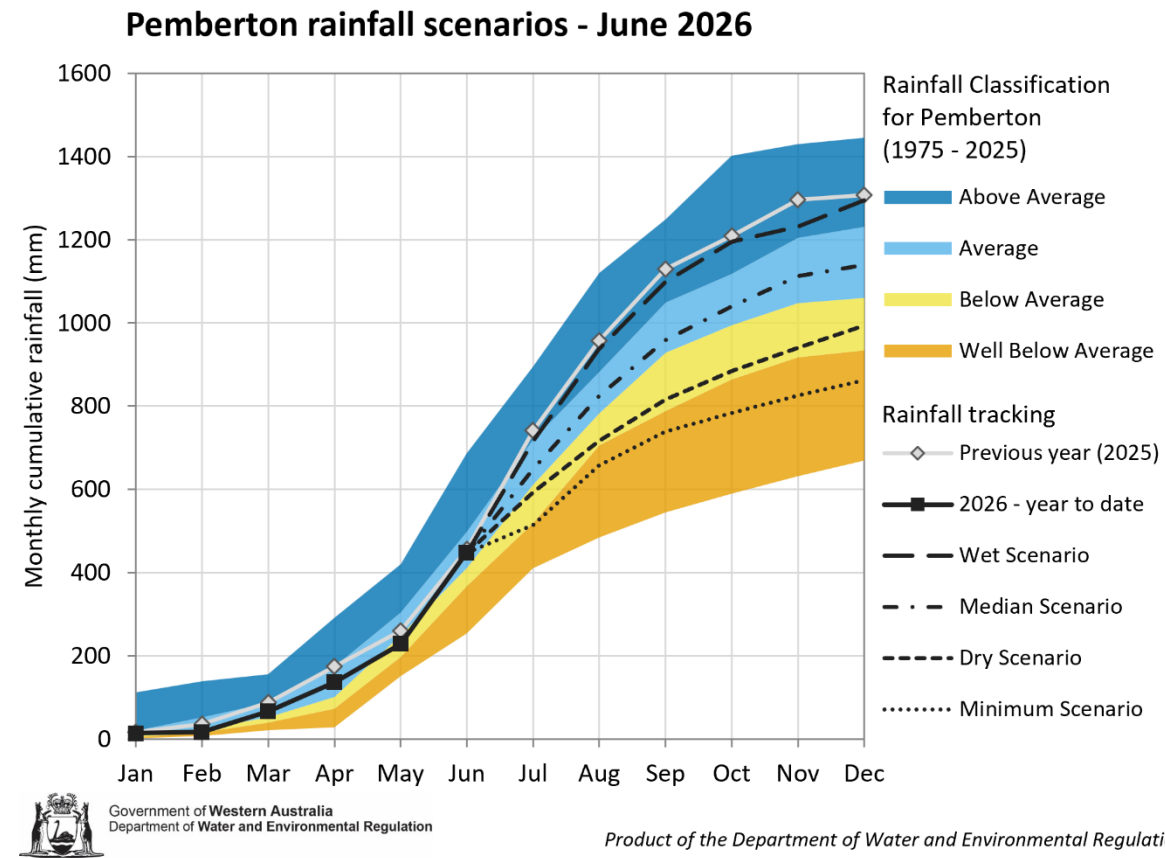
#### Harvey River

## Streamflow

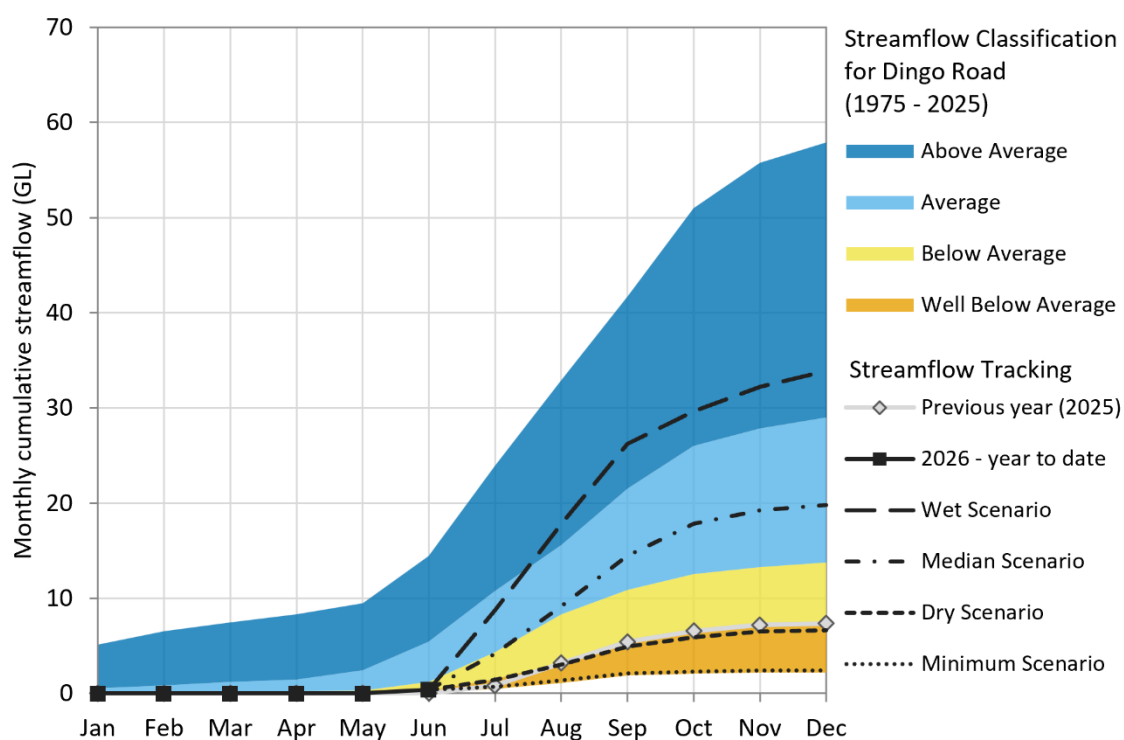
### Harvey River, Pemberton (Lefroy Brook)

#### Harvey River streamflow scenarios - June 2026



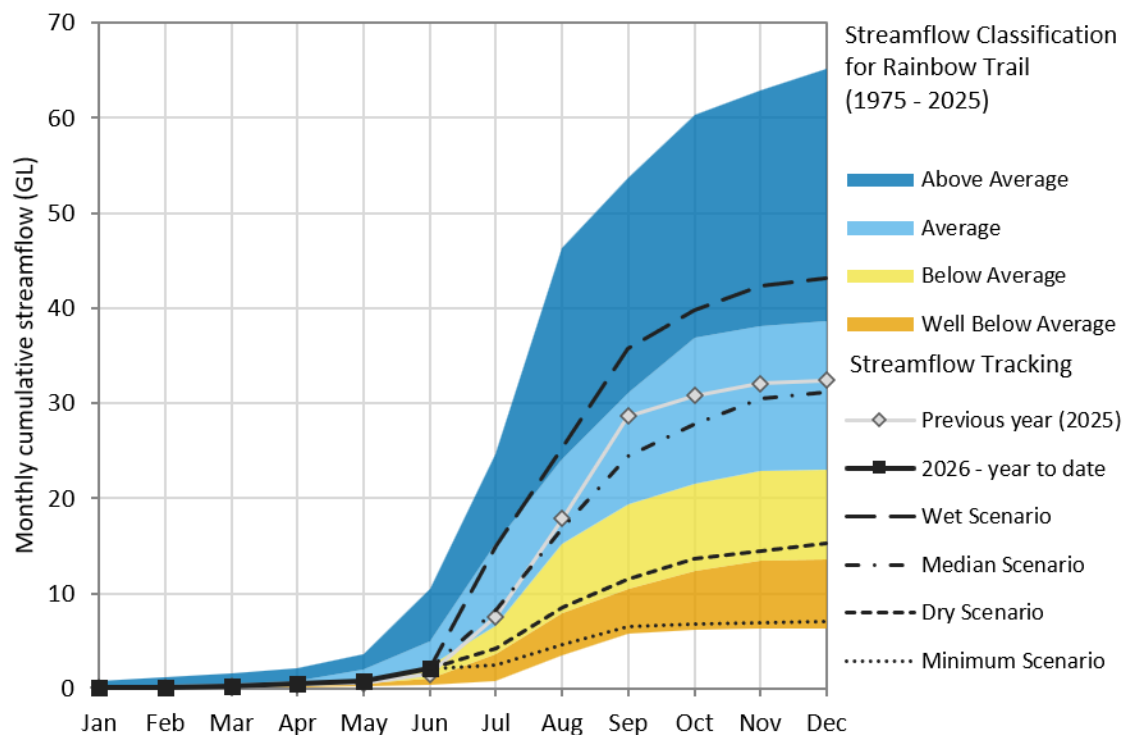

### Lefroy Brook streamflow scenarios - June 2026



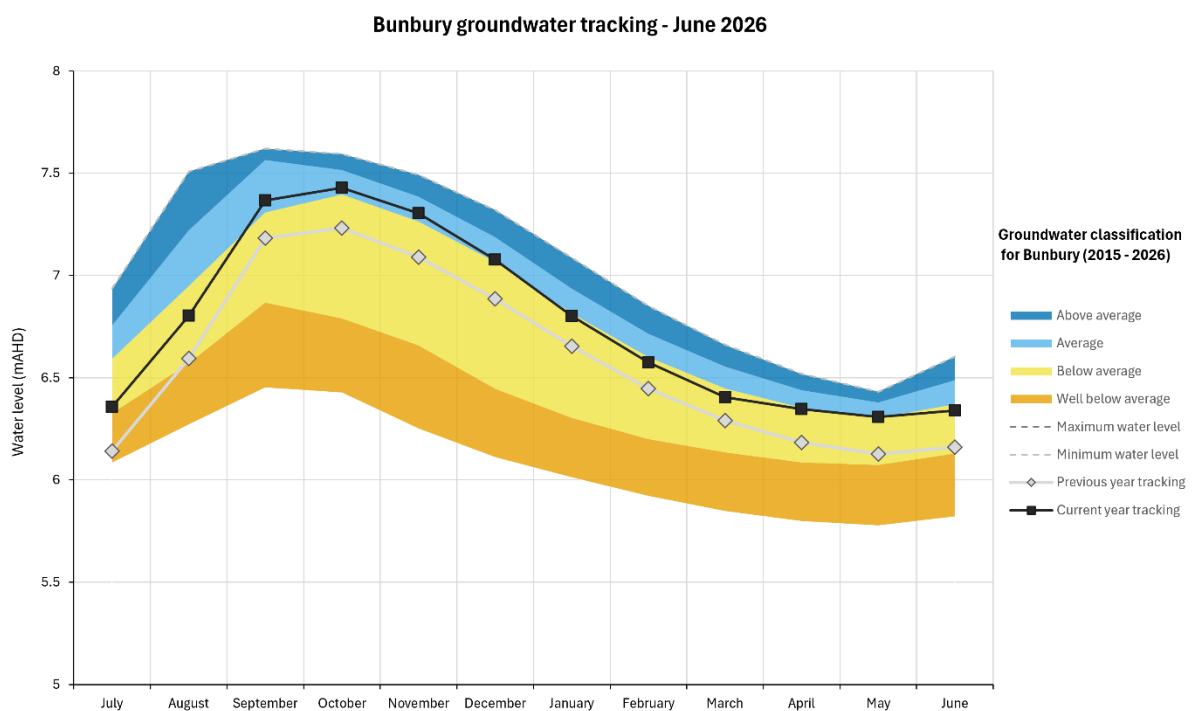

Groundwater levels at the representative bore in Bunbury are tracking below average and are higher than groundwater levels recorded in the previous year.

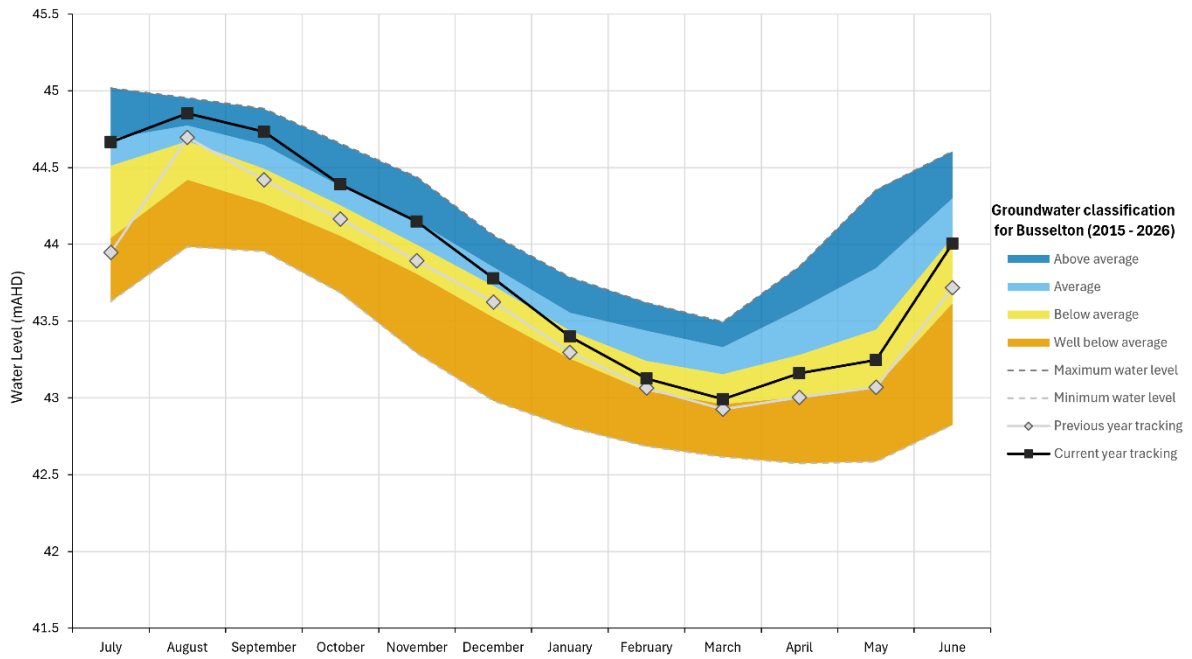
