Shire of Carnarvon	Carnarvon Litter Legends Regatta	The Carnarvon Litter Legends Regatta will educate and engage the community about litter reduction, marine debris and waste avoidance through a fun, hands-on project. Led by the Carnarvon Litter Legends volunteer group, participants will collect and repurpose litter and unwanted materials to build boats for a community regatta. The project includes workshops on low-waste events and creative reuse, supported by local businesses, schools and community organisations. Through six months of promotion, clean-up activities and community participation, the project will increase awareness of litter issues, encourage behaviour change and demonstrate practical ways to reuse materials that otherwise end up in landfill.	\$ 5,494.00
Perfect Nature Cruises	Steep Point Clean Up Dive	The Steep Point Clean Up Dive will reduce marine litter at Australia's most western mainland point, in Shark Bay World Heritage Area. The project will unite volunteer divers, tourism operators, Traditional Owners and stakeholders removing fishing-related debris from remote coastal environments while promoting responsible visitation and litter prevention. Previous small-scale clean-up dives removed 70 kg of lead and copious amounts of fishing waste revealing the scale of hidden underwater waste. KAB funding will allow to greatly expand the impact through increased dive effort, improved waste recovery, debris recording, educational signage and short awareness documentary for lasting behavioural change.	\$ 10,000.00
Esperance Wildlife Sanctuary Inc.	Beneath the Surface: Esperance Marine Litter Recovery, Education & Prevention Project	Supported by the Shire of Esperance, DBCA, and local service clubs, the "Beneath the Surface" project will address submerged marine litter at the Esperance Tanker Jetty and Lucky Bay. Discarded fishing gear and plastics cause severe entanglement injuries to wildlife. To mitigate this, the initiative will utilise local divers to safely recover underwater debris. Underwater videographers will record the event and showcase the beauty of marine life. The retrieved litter and video will form a high-impact educational campaign to bridge community knowledge gaps, the project also installs dedicated tackle bins and interpretive signage to capture high-risk litter at its source.	\$ 10,000.00
Wildlife Allies	Pick up Litter for Critters	This project will educate the community about litter that causes direct injury to wildlife. This project will be an educational campaign highlighting the direct impact litter has on native wildlife and how safely disposing of litter and picking it up can save a wild life. An artist will produce a poster, flyer and social media campaign. We will also host multiple public clean ups at known wildlife and litter hotspots in Perth during the campaign period.	\$ 3,675.00

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City of Bunbury	Captain Coast Care and Dune Dude Pantomimes	Captain Coast Care and Dune Dude is an original family-friendly pantomime developed by the Acting Up Theatre Company to educate and inspire communities to reduce litter, recycle responsibly, and take pride in public spaces through comedy, audience participation, and live theatre. Two pantomimes will be scheduled at each of the City of Bunbury's signature events; Christmas in the City and Sky Fest which form part of the Summer Lovin summer activation campaign. An additional two pantomimes will be presented at the Dolphin Discovery Centre during the January school holidays.	\$ 3,469.00
Transition Bridgetown Inc	Blackwood River - Clean and Litter Free	The Blackwood River – Clean and Litter Free is a hands-on community event focused on reducing litter entering the Blackwood River and its tributaries. Participants will join SUP Tonic for guided stand-up paddle board clean-ups, while land-based volunteers collect and sort litter along the foreshore. All litter will be identified, weighed and recorded using a standard audit process. The data collected will highlight key litter types and sources and will be shared with Transition Bridgetown, the Shire and community groups to guide future litter prevention action. The event combines education, participation and real-world data to drive long-term behavioural practice change.	\$ 3,300.00
Mount Claremont PS P&C Inc.	Pride in Place: A Market Community Litter Prevention Project	The Mount Claremont Farmers Market will deliver a market community litter awareness campaign that educates visitors on simple actions to keep our environment clean. The project includes a community clean-up event, additional bins, and a creative bin-decoration initiative involving local school students and a local artist. A custom cartoon character will lead the campaign, promoting positive litter-prevention messages. By combining education, community participation, and improved infrastructure, the project aims to reduce litter and create lasting behavioural change across the market and surrounding neighbourhood.	\$ 7,965.00
Ocean Road Primary School	Ripple Effect: Small Actions, Big Change	This project will empower students and families to take action against litter through education, community involvement and environmental stewardship. Students will participate in workshops led by Estuary Guardians, learning about the impacts of litter on local ecosystems and ways to protect them. Classes will take responsibility for collecting litter from designated areas around the school, local estuary and beach. A selection of fiction and non-fiction texts will be purchased to engage and educate students about litter reduction. Families will be invited to join the clean-up events, fostering community pride and a shared commitment to keeping our environment clean.	\$ 1,797.00
