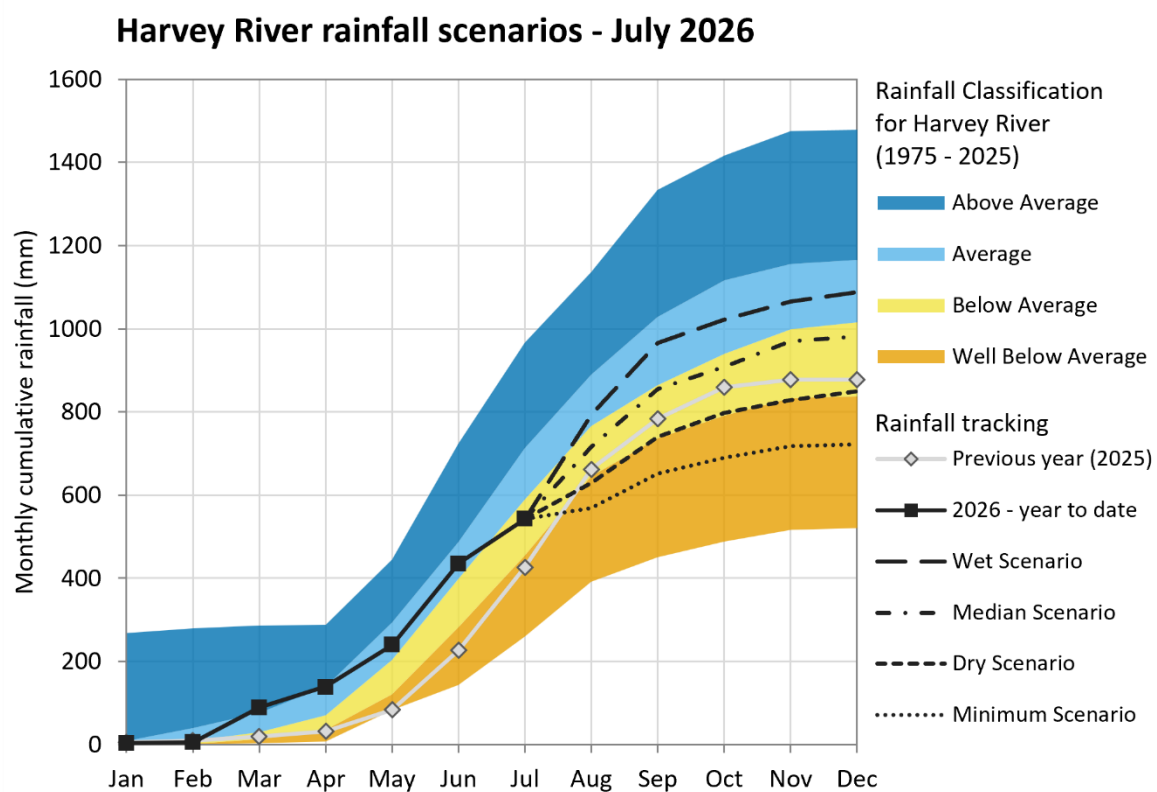
Rainfall

Rainfall in Harvey is currently tracking in the below average category.

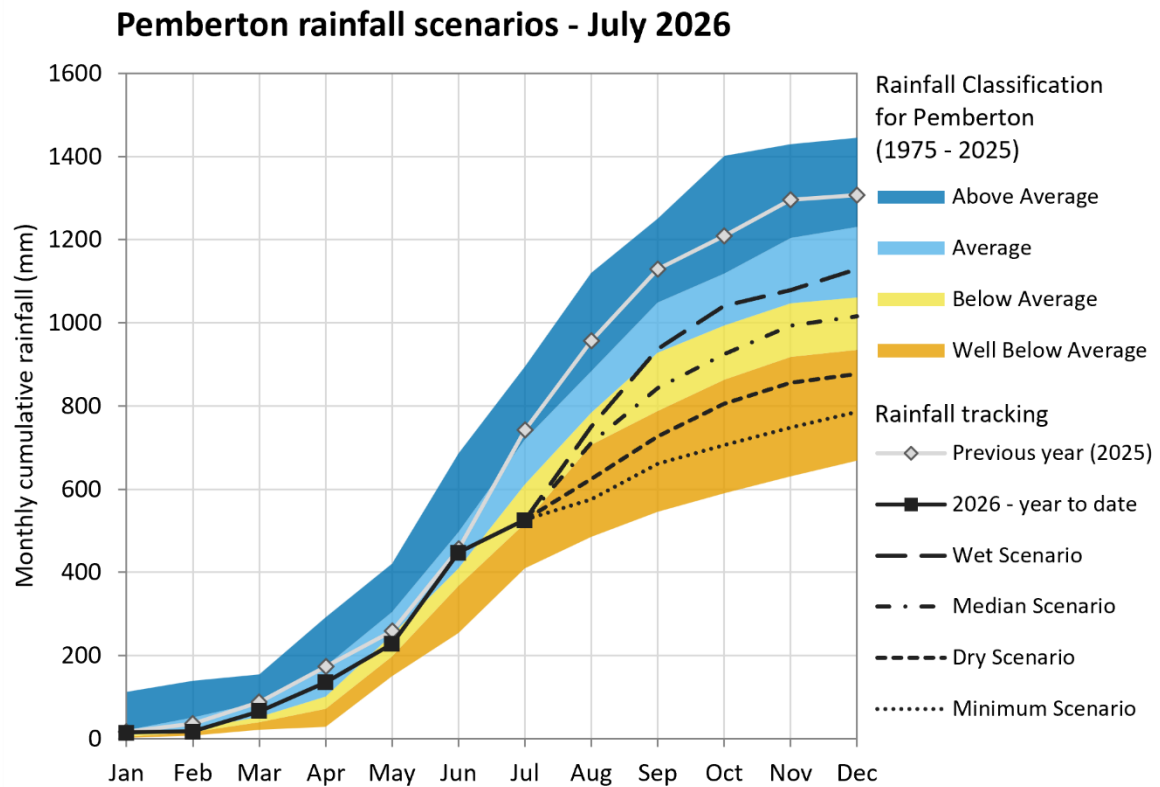


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Pemberton

Rainfall in Pemberton is tracking in the below average category.



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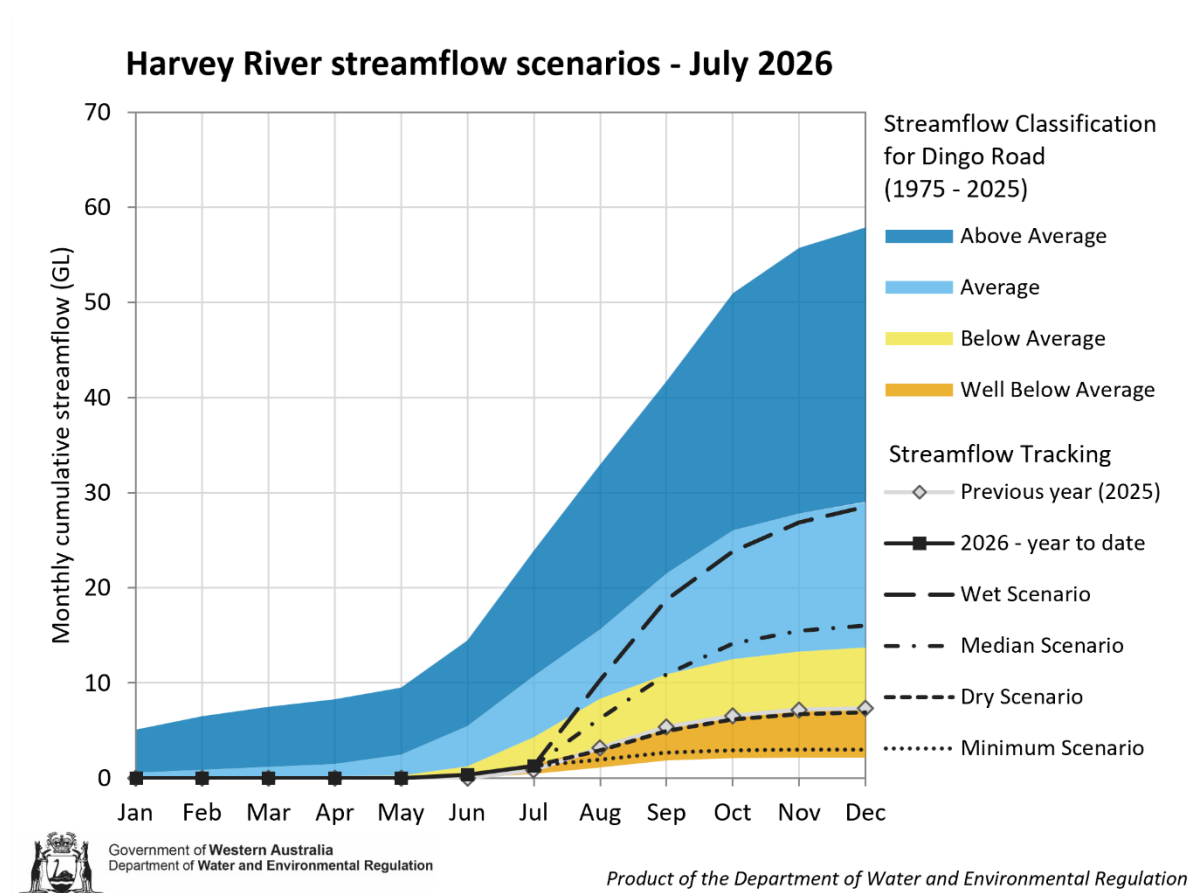
Streamflow

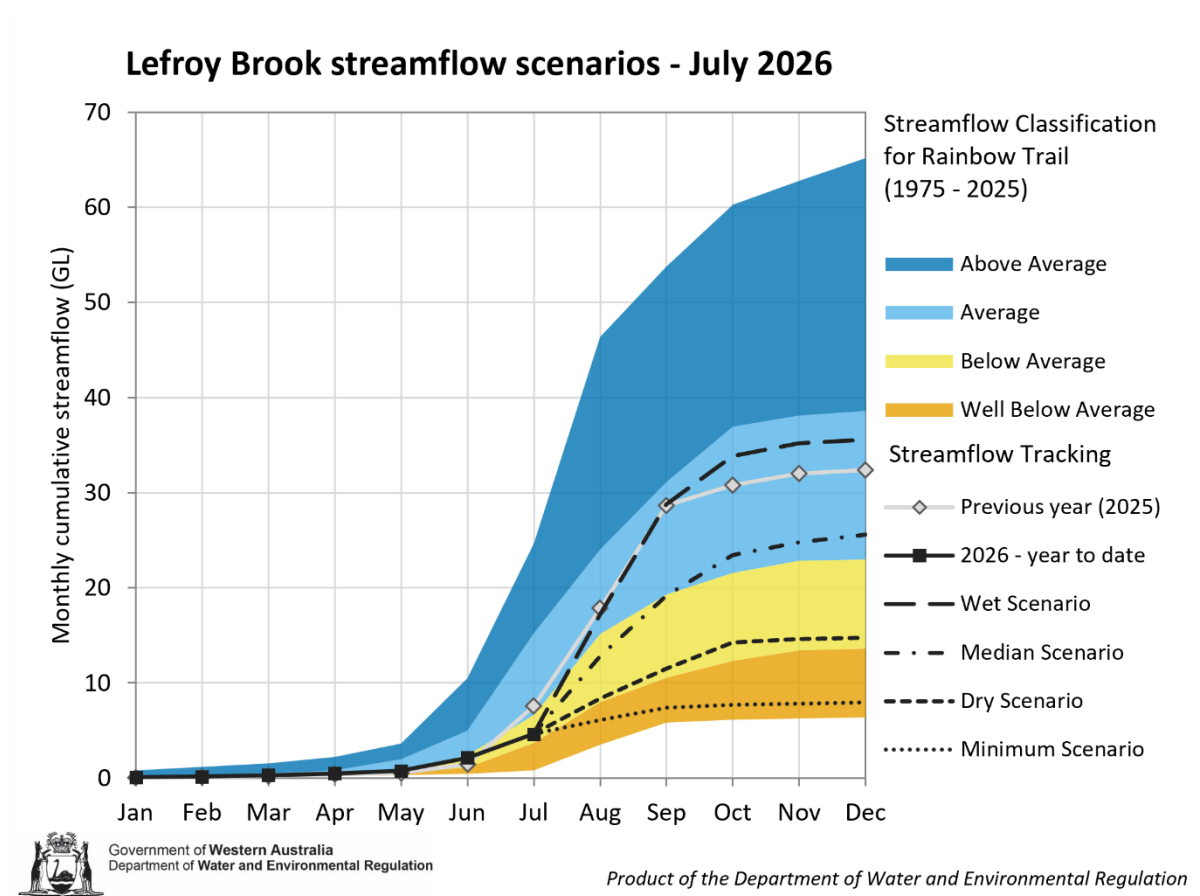
Harvey River

Pemberton (Lefroy Brook)

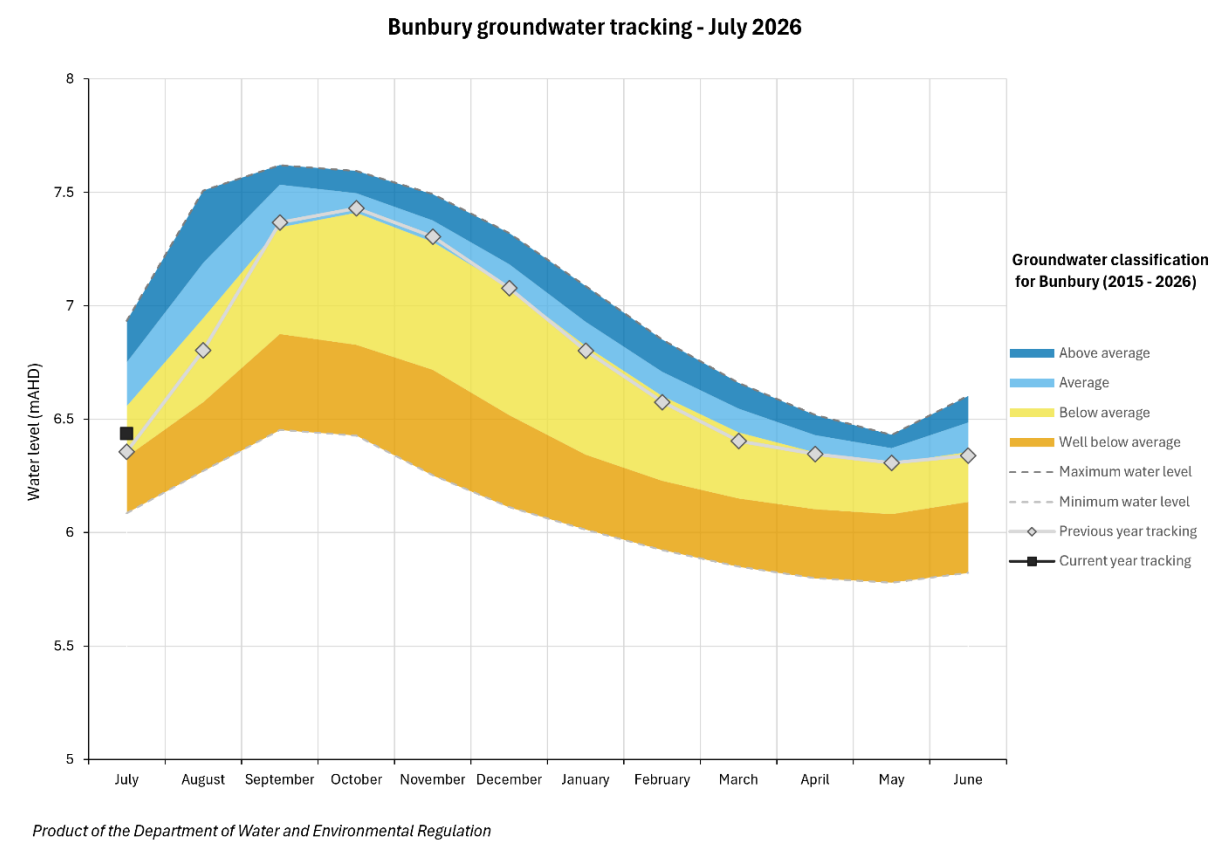
Streamflow in Lefroy Brook, near Pemberton is tracking in the below average category.

Bunbury

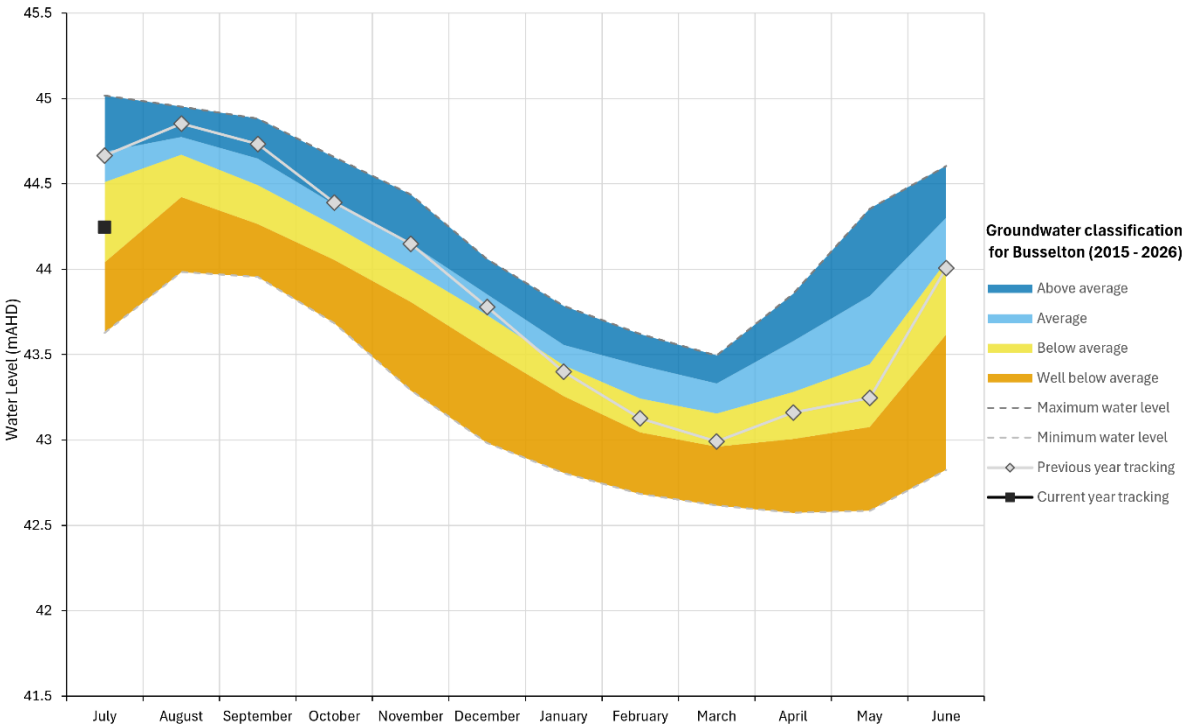
Groundwater levels at the representative bore in Bunbury are tracking below average and are higher than groundwater levels recorded in the previous year.

Busselton groundwater tracking - July 2026

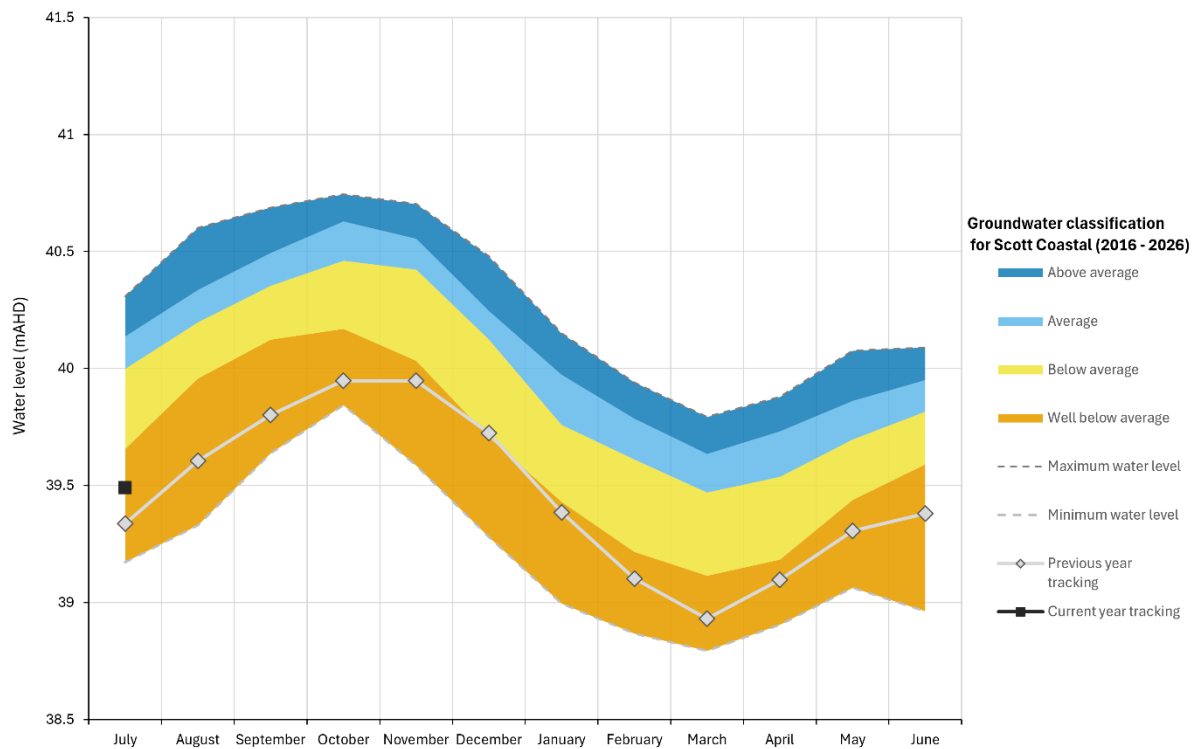


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Scott Coastal
