

- Forty-three fuel station inspections this week for a total of 2,805 inspections since the start of our inspection blitz in early March. All sites were compliant. Infringements remain steady at 123.
- Fuel supplies are stable for October through to mid-November and fuel station stockouts continue to remain low across the State.
- Shipments of fuel to WA continue in line with recent trends with 43 tankers in transit to Australia.
- There is more fuel in WA now than at the same time last year.
- We're continuing to work actively with industry to ensure WA has access to the most detailed supply chain information in the country.
- Over 1,200,000 Western Australians have claimed the \$100 Fuel Support Payment. More information at wa.gov.au/FuelPayment
